TRAVELLING TO THE WILLIAM HILL WINTER FESTIVAL

As with all major sporting events, we do advise that you arrive as early as possible to avoid delay in accessing the course. Our gates open at 10am on both

days of the festival - so arrive early and enjoy the atmosphere.

Following racing, our bars will be open for up to one hour and you can also enjoy live music which will continue to play, so sit back and relax whilst avoiding the congestion leaving the site.

Travelling by Public Transport

Train

Friday 26 December - No trains due to network shutdown. Please use the London Underground where possible or take advantage of our Park & Ride service which is free of charge.

Saturday 27 December - Normal service resumes on the London Waterloo to Shepperton line. Please check www.swtrains.co.uk for more information. The journey time from London is approximately 45 minutes.

Bus

Unfortunately, bus services to Kempton Park are limited and only operate in the very local vicinity. Details of the bus services operating in the Kempton Park area can be obtained by contacting the Transport for London Travel Information Line on 0843 222 1234.

Travelling by London Underground

Friday 26 December - A bus service will be in operation from Kew underground station. There will be a return fare for this service of £3.50 for adults and £2.50 for children 16 and under and senior citizens. We highly recommend that you take advantage of this service.

Travelling by car, minibus or coach

Kempton Park works closely with Surrey Police to speed access to the racecourse. All visitors are advised to follow the signs to the course as these mark out the most direct traffic managed routes. We would advise all customers using the Park & Ride service to exit the M3 at Junction 1 following the signs. All other customers using on course car parks should exit the A316 at Feltham, travel under the carriageway and rejoin in the opposite direction exiting at the Kempton Park junction. This is the best route into the racecourse on busy days.

Disabled Parking

Disabled visitors should display their blue labels and travel directly to either the Main Car Park or Car Park B where spaces will be available free of charge on the day.

Park & Ride - Friday 26 December only

There will be a free Park & Ride service operating in Sunbury-on-Thames which will be clearly signposted from Junction 1 of the M3. The site will offer secure parking on a well lit multi storey site and will offer parking for 850 cars. The site is just five minutes from the racecourse via a free shuttle bus.

At busy times, the shuttle bus service will drop racegoers off a short walk from the main entrance to avoid any delays. This car park is highly recommended and will significantly reduce delays both entering and exiting the site. Please follow the signs to the Park & Ride to take advantage of this service. Please note, we do not recommend that disabled visitors or families with pushchairs use the Park & Ride service.

If you are collecting your tickets on the day, please use the Park & Ride service.
